Merlot 40%, Cabernet Sauvignon 30%, Cabernet Franc 30%


A FAMILY BUSINESS

Guido and Nobuko Busetto bought Selvole in 1999.

Their passion for quality wine started while living in France, where Guido was working as a correspondent for the economic daily paper II Sole 24 Ore. They both studied at the Enology Institute of Bordeaux University. After 25 years of active journalism and a good knowledge of winemaking, the decision to buy a winery and produce wine seemed a natural transition.



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HISTORY

One of the oldest wineries of Tuscany, Selvole produces around 80.000 bottles of wine every year.

The vineyards are located in the valley between Selvole and Brolio where, Chianti Classico was born 300 years ago. Half of the 16 hectares of vineyard have been recently planted at extremely high density with Sangiovese, Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon.

Gran Selezione

Three years of aging in French oak barrels delivers a wine with unmatched elegance and body.

Sangiovese 80%, Merlot 10%, Cabernet 10%

Riserva

The Riserva is a wine with sophisticated flavor, a slight hint of wood, complex and intense scent and colors.

Sangiovese 100%

Annata

The most Classic of Chianti Classico, with all the fragrance and color intensity of a great wine Sangiovese 100%

SINGLE VARIETAL

Merlot

A French grape variety grown in Tuscany gives the wine an intense body and fragrance.

Cabernet Sauvignon

The most famous grape variety in the world cultivated on clay soil brings a wide, structured and intense wine.

Cabernet Franc

French vine shoots planted at high intensity for a Cabernet Franc of uncommon intensity and strength.
